"No one sews a patch of unshrunk cloth on an old garment. Otherwise, the new piece will pull away from the old, making the tear worse. And no one pours new wine into old wineskins. Otherwise, the wine will burst the skins, and both the wine and the wineskins will be ruined. No, they pour new wine into new wineskins." (Mark 2:21-22)

When my Grandpa was a pastor, he was one of the most respected men in town. That was 70 years ago, when societal pressures dictated that everybody be in church on Sunday mornings. Back then, churches didn't have to focus on outreach. In most towns, people just came.

But times have changed. Churches today are entering uncharted territory. Gone are the days when churches held privileged status in society. Instead, most people have ambivalence towards the church. Less and less people are familiar with church culture, and stories about clergy abuse scandals only increase skepticism towards the church.

But studies also show record amounts of interest in spiritual things. Our nation is full of young people seeking a life of meaning, of connection, of divine purpose. They just aren't seeking it in the church.

I'm convinced that the church today has a real opportunity. The hope of Jesus Christ is that for which our world hungers. But people aren't just going to stumble upon us. We have to be proactive in taking the church to them. I'm convinced that successful churches in the 21st century must learn to think like missionaries. We're going to have to try some new things! Goochland Baptist Church is changing up our Wednesday night routine this fall. We'll still gather our family around the table for a homecooked meal (starting at 5:30), but we're going to add something to it: mission. Each month, we'll have an inter-generational mission project for our children, youth, and grandparents (and everyone in between) to work on together. We'll actually participate in the project itself on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday nights each month. On the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays, our children and youth will leave at 6:00 pm for their own hour of music and missions, while our adults will hear from a special guest on the 2nd Wednesday and participate in an interactive Bible study on the 4th Wednesday.

I'm excited for our new missional experiment. Not only will we be shifting the focus to blessing others outside our church, but we'll also be able to teach our children and young people important lessons about serving our neighbors. I hope you'll join us.

This will be the first of several experiments we'll try. October will a be a big month for us: a month to focus on our future. All throughout the Sundays of October, we'll concentrate on Discovering Tomorrow Together. You'll get an invitation with more details, but we hope you'll join us as we begin to discern together what God has in store for Goochland Baptist Church.

Erin and I have only been at Goochland Baptist for 19 months, but I'm convinced that we've got a bright future with a lot to be excited about. I hope you'll join us in the months ahead as we experiment with some new ways of doing things and open ourselves to God's vision.


